Grossman is one of the world's foremost experts and speakers on the psychology of conflict. Army Ranger, West Point Psychology Professor, author of the Pulitzer nominated books: *On Killing*, and *Stop Teaching Our Kids to Kill*, and the new book, *On Combat*. He has written numerous encyclopedia entries and an entry in *The Oxford Companion to American Military History*. Also, he has presented papers to the AMA, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the American Psychological Association. Grossman is the co-author of an entry on active shooter terrorism response in the *Harvard Journal of Law and Public Policy*. He has testified before House and Senate committees, and he and his research have been cited by the President in a national address.
