

It was a rather quiet week to start the second half of the 2015 legislative session. Of the 1257 introduced bills at the start of the legislature, only 394 survived the first half. All bills have been received their new committee assignments this past week. We will continue to keep you up to date as everything moves through the process this half.

Here are some upcoming deadlines for the 2015 Session.

- Thursday, April 9th – Committee Report Deadline for Senate Bills in the House
- Thursday, April 9th – Committee Report Deadline for House Bills in the Senate
- Wednesday, April 15th – Last day for 3rd Reading of House bills in the Senate
- Wednesday, April 15th – Last day for 3rd Reading of Senate bills in the House
- Wednesday, April 29th – Last day for adjournment (Sine Die)

The following bills on your Bill Track list are scheduled for a committee hearing next week:

- **HB 1216 (Missing Children and Trafficked Children)** – Scheduled to be heard on Monday in the Senate Family & Children Services Committee.
