

Less than a week remains for the 2015 legislative session. Numerous conference committees were held this past week. However, many bills, such as the budget (HB 1001) are still in their final negotiations with key lawmakers. As mentioned last week, both the House and Senate version of the budget increased annual spending more than Governor Pence's proposed budget, which was released in early January. Adding to the Governor's concern over the proposed spending increase was last week's revenue forecast, which was less than stellar. Indiana's revenue collections have been below their projected levels for seven of the last nine months. Members of the General Assembly have until this Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup> to find a compromise and vote out a budget before Sine Die.

Here are some upcoming deadlines for the 2015 Session.

- Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup> – Last day for adjournment (**Sine Die**)
