Chief Dusty Luking Elected IACP Secretary/Treasurer

Indianapolis, IN (February 14, 2017) — At its Mid-Winter Conference, the Indiana Association of Chiefs of Police elected Chief Dusty Luking of the Vincennes Police Department as Secretary/Treasurer for the year 2017. Previously serving as District 10 Director, Luking has been a member of the IACP Board of Directors since 2015.

Chief Dusty Luking is a twenty-one year veteran of the Vincennes Indiana Police Department. Working in the investigative division since 2003 as a Sergeant and Lieutenant, he was appointed as Police Chief in January of 2012. Chief Luking worked in patrol and as a school liaison, DARE officer, and general law enforcement instructor. He was a member of the department Emergency Response Team.

Chief Luking majored in law enforcement and earned his degree at Vincennes University. He is a graduate of the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy. He attended DARE officer training in 1999. He is a certified medicolegal death investigator, crime scene technician, crisis negotiator, and an expert witness in marijuana identification.

Chief Luking has been decorated four times by the Vincennes Police Department Merit Commission for life saving performance in the line of duty. In 2004 Chief Luking was recognized by the Illinois State Police for exceptional bravery and received a medal and award for his actions from Director Larry Trent.
